Make memories surrounded by community gardens and have Antonio Peralta's 1870 Victorian historical house and museum on the background. Visitors can walk around the six-acre site and enjoy the outdoor exhibits and shaded paths around Peralta creek.

This facility is the community hub of the historical site and is conveniently located just minutes from the I-580 and I-880 freeways and is walking distance from the Fruitvale Bart station.

The community center can accommodate up to 46 people indoors. Two sliding doors open on opposite sides of the building to increase seating capacity. The outdoors grass area behind the center is also available for seating and it can accommodate up to 100 people.

- Two restrooms are available for all rentals.
- The decorative sliding gate makes it possible to create privacy when the sliding doors are open.
- Authentic Mexican and Salvadorian catering restaurants located within minutes of the site.
- Tour of the Peralta House Museum included upon request (4-hour rental minimum). A local and state landmark listed on the National Register of Historic Places, this farmhouse represents Spanishspeaking California on the cusp of a new era after the Gold Rush and annexation of California by the United States. Externally, the house is restored and maintained to its original appearance, and inside it houses permanent and temporary exhibits.


